We light a candle, close our eyes and hold hands. The sauce pan lid of copper shines and spins around on the floorboard. Will we go back 100 years in time, or maybe in to the 50s? Our journey is about to begin...

Trough the magic of play, children and adults move to another time age. Time Travel is a drama play and a treat for the senses. With play as method, you as an educator can create a historical perspective and provide children with a comprehensive picture of the “old days”. Play, empathy and imagination are the backbone of time travel. Time Travel is an enjoyable way to generate interest and curiosity for both past and present!

Time Travel at Jamtli celebrates its 25 years mark this year! Over the years it has gained many followers all over Scandinavia. From Time Travel at Jamtli, interactive exhibits for children such as “Playhouses” and “Play and Learn-environments” have emerged.

Other examples of innovation is time travel and RPG with value themes for older students, “Little Journey” with puppets and storytelling for 2-3 year olds and most recently, “The rope of time” – for disabled children and young people. The variations are many and continue to grow...
