1895, Mountain farm (Fäboden)

1824, Gest House and Court (Tingshuset) Guest House and courtroom. Every other 10 km, there would be an inn where visitors could switch to a rested horse. Before the hearing in the court, the accused could be put in custody.



1. The Stone Age

The Överhogdal tapestries are the best preserved Viking tapestries in existence, and date from between 1040 to 1170 AD. As an introduction, there is a slide show about the tapestries, and an exhibition about the Vikings.

4. Wartimes

Between 1563 and 1720, Jämtland and Härjedalen were caught between Sweden and Denmark-Norway. The period ended in a terrible disaster when King Charles XII's northern army was caught in a blizzard in the mountains and many thousands of soldiers died.
