1895, The Market Square, Östersund (Torget)
Welcome to a city that is growing at quite a pace! The railway has just reached the city, and in the J.P. Gulle general store, goods from the four corners of the world are sold. In the alley day-labourers and artisans live in cramped conditions. *Especially for small children*

Hackåsgården
Play shop, try make-believe cooking or play in the steamer Lill-Thomée! Jump in the hay and look after the friendly animals.

1895, Näsgråden, farm
The farmer Jöns Ol's and his family live in Ålsta in the parish of Näs. These are exciting times with many new inventions and ideas. Separators and harvesters facilitate work, while the temperance movement is becoming an important factor in social life.

1895, Mountain farm (Fåboden)
Did you wonder where the live stock of Näsgråden were? At the summer pastures in the

mountains, of course! Here, they can graze all summer, while the fields closer to the farm are being cultivated. Girls from Näsgråden look after the cows and the goats, milking them and making cheese.

1785, Lillhårdalsgården, farm
Sheriff Kjell Herdell and his family live on a farm in Lillhårdal in Härjedalen. Self-sufficiency is the order of the day, and the family produces everything it needs.

1824, Gest House and Court (Tingshuset)
Every other 10 km, there would be an inn where visitors could switch to a rested horse. Before the hearing in the court, the accused could be put in custody.

1942, Forest cabin (Skogskojan)
Workers cook their food, eat and sleep in the cabin, and also keep tools and harnesses in here.

1942, Per Albin-torpet – the croft
Astrid and Sture Zetterström have borrowed money from the own-your-own home movement to build a croft of their own. But the

outbreak of war has changed everything and Sture has been called up. When he comes home on leave, the croft overflows with happiness.

1956, Service station and driving school (Macken)
A trip down memory lane with a petrol pump, car, bicycle and motorbike workshops, a car showroom and a kiosks.

1975, A modern society (Det moderna samhället)
Visit the family who has moved into their first house, the old age pensioners and the people who are trying to avoid modern life. The discovery park is based on a popular children's programme first broadcasted in 1973–1975, "Five ants are more than four elephants", with rights granted from SVT and the creators.

ANCIENT TIMES

1. The Stone Age
A little girl is describing fish in the Stone age exhibition, which describes how people in Jämtland and Härjedalen lived some 5,000 years ago.

2. Vikings and the Överhogdal tapestries
The Överhogdal tapestries are the best preserved Viking tapestries in existence, and date from between 1040 to 1170 AD. As an introduction, there is a slide show about the tapestries, and an exhibition about the Vikings.

WAR AND PEACE
War and Peace covers the period from when Jämtland and Härjedalen were Christianized until the end of the Swedish Empire and more peaceful times began.

3. The Middle Ages
Explore the medieval church with beautiful objects and images of saints.

4. Wartimes
Between 1563 and 1720, Jämtland and Härjedalen were caught between Sweden and Denmark-Norway. The period ended in a disaster when King Charles XII's northern army was caught in a blizzard in the mountains and many thousands of soldiers died.

5. Bliss and Bounty
Between 1750 and 1850, folk art flourished and many beautiful objects come from this period.

6. Farming life
How did people live in the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries? Here you will see a woman surrounded by her daily work, a bit further on you will find her husband busy with his tasks. Can you see the travelling farmer's horse and sledge? Here you get a sense of what it was like to travel to market to sell furs, grouse, butter and cheese. It was a long journey for the Jämtland farmers who

travelled all the way to Norway and to areas around Stockholm.

7. Aajeh – a Sami spring
A walk around the mountains will take you through the Sami year to experience Sami culture and reindeer herding. In the turf hut, you are invited to sit down to listen to a Sami life story, and to behold the mountain Nils Thomasson's beautiful Sami photos are on show.
